We hope your summer has been wonderful and that you continue to have a great time during the last few weeks. We will see you on September 1st, for the first day of school. You will need to be in your homeroom by 7:55 AM. Please bring your schedule with you the first day.

The Richmond School sixth grade has **an assignment book**, which will be available the first week of school. In addition, on the first day of school, you should have the following **general supplies**:

- one three ring binder with dividers for each academic class (including French)
- a pen/pencil case that fits in your binder
- a “gi-normous” supply of #2 pencils (mechanical pencils and refills even better)
- black or blue ink pens
- several different colored highlighters
- a supply of lined paper
- a ruler that fits in the binder marked with centimeters and inches
- several packages of Post-it Notes in various sizes
- a few jumbo “Book Sox” to cover your textbooks
- USB flashdrive (**Please format to your home computer before the first day of school**)

**You will also need the following for specific classes:**

**English:** your summer reading list, signed by a parent, and your letter to Ms. Sylvester

**Math:** a spiral bound graph paper notebook, 1 ½ inch three -ring view binder and a four function calculator

**Physical Education:** sweatpants or shorts, sneakers; a journal (notebook or composition book)

**Social Studies:** a composition notebook

During the school year, you will also need: (keep at home until needed)

- colored pencils and/or markers
- 3x5 cards
- whiteout
- large poster board.
- scissors
- glue sticks
- extra pens and pencils

- extra white-lined paper

You will use supplies up faster than you expect: **be prepared to replenish supplies regularly throughout the year**. Binders typically need replacing at least once during the school year. Please put your name on your supplies and belongings (including your clothing and your flashdrive) before you bring them to school. We look forward to seeing you on September 1st.
