- compass & protractor
- metric/standard ruler
- USB flash drive: highly recommended

Composition Notebooks, wide-lined (8 1/2" X 11") English, Spanish, Social Studies (Wilhelm) and Science (Wallis and Stott)

French: thin portfolio folder with 2 pockets, under \$1.00

Math Notebook: Please wait until you meet with your math teacher before you purchase one as each teacher has a slightly different notebook requirement.

Throughout the school year, you will be involved in many projects that may require project materials. We suggest that you keep a supply of the following at home:

- poster paper
- construction paper
- markers
- glue sticks
